As petitioner, you must give the petition and notice of the scheduled hearing to the persons listed below at least seven (7) days prior to the hearing if served personally, or fourteen (14) days prior to the hearing if served by mail:

- 1. Protected individual The law requires the subject of the Petition to be present at the hearing, unless physically unable to do so. The doctor's statement, which accompanies the Petition, must address the person's ability to attend the hearing.
- 2. Protected individual's spouse
- Protected individual's children
- 4. Presumptive heirs
- 5. If there are no known heirs, or presumptive heirs, the Attorney General
- 6. Nominated Conservator
- 7. If known, a person named as attorney in fact under a durable power of attorney
- 8. A governmental agency paying benefits to the individual to be protected or before which an application for benefits is pending including but not limited to Veterans Administration, Social Security Administration, Michigan Family Independence Agency
- 9. Person who files a Demand for Notice under MCL 700.5104(1)
- 10. Publication if there are no known heirs
